



FORTRESSES AND CASTLES IN THE MARCHE REGION



There are numerous castles and palaces in the Marche that host initiatives, exhibitions or permanent museums:

the **Torrione di Cagli** is home to a Contemporary Sculpture Center (works by E. Mattiaci, J. Kounellis, H. Nagasawa etc.);

the **Rocca di Sassocorvaro** hosts the **Ark of Art** created to remember the rescue of 10,000 works of art during the Second World War;

the **Rocca di Gradara** preserves Renaissance pictorial cycles;

a Weapons Museum is set up in **Mondavio**.

Urbino hosts the **National Gallery of the Marche**;

a technical-scientific museum has been set up in **Palazzo Brancaleoni in Piobbico**;

in **Senigallia** the **Rocca Roveresca** hosts a permanent exhibition on the Della Rovere family;

the Medieval Festivals take place in the **Rocca di Offagna**;

the **Rancia Castle in Tolentino** hosts temporary exhibitions;

the **Rocca di Acquaviva Picena** is the scene of the Palio del Duca and houses the Multimedia Museum "La Fortezza nel Tempo" in the keep;

the **Rocca di Urbisaglia** contains a Weapons Museum;

Castel di Luco is currently private property of the Amici family, open to the public.
